TREE PRESERVATION ORDER (EH1086) 2018

East Hampshire District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 hereby make the following Order -

Citation

1.This Order may be cited as East Hampshire (St Josephs Catholic Church, Headley Road, Grayshott, Hindhead, GU26 6DP) Tree Preservation Order (EH1086) 2018.

Interpretation

2.(1) In this Order "the authority" means East Hampshire District Council.

(2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

3.(1) Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.

(2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall—

(a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage, or wilfully destroy; or

(b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

Reference on Map	Description	Situation
G1	2xBeech	On front boundary immediately East of the eastern most entrance as shown on the attached plan.
G2	2xBeech 2xSweet Chestnut	At the front of the church in the North East corner of the curtilage as shown on the attached plan.

SPECIFICATION OF TREES

Trees specified individually
(encircled in green on the map)

Reference on Map	Description	Situation
T1	Scots Pine	Approximately 8 metres North West of the South Eastern most corner of the curtilage.
T2	Sweet Chestnut	Approximately 28 metres South of Harvey House and 38 metres from the Western boundary.
